## What You'll Need for Training Class

### For the First Night:

- A copy of the dog's current **vaccination records**. (Puppies must have 2 shots 3 weeks apart before coming to the club/training facility.)

***NOTE: If you are taking a puppy, adolescent, or a good manners 1 class, DO NOT bring your dog to the first class as this is an orientation class for owners without their dogs.***

- **You must be registered to take a class.** Go to [nvdtc.org/registration.htm](http://nvdtc.org/registration.htm) to register. If online registration is closed for the current session and you have registered through the office by phone, you will need to create an account by going to: [nvdtc.org/registration.htm](http://nvdtc.org/registration.htm) and clicking on the "Create an Account" button.
- **Payment:**
  - 1) Payment can be made at time of registration using Paypal or credit card.
  - 2) If paying by check, payment must be received by NVDTTC within four business days of registering online by sending to: Napa Valley Dog Training Club, 68 Coombs Street Box 7, Napa CA 94559. If payment is not received on time, your name will be put on a waiting list.
  - 3) Payments made day of class are acceptable only if registering for a class through the office after online registration has closed for the current session.

### For Each Week of Training:

- 6' leather or nylon lead (leash). If you use a flexi-lead (retractable leash) at home, please switch your pet over to the more sturdy lead before entering the training facility.
- Flat buckle or quick release collar. If you feel your dog would do well with a special training collar or harness – please speak with the instructor prior to class.
- Light-weight bed, blanket or towel for use in class.
- Lots-n-lots of small, SOFT treats that the dog can easily eat and enjoys. Try to pack 3 or 4 different kinds of goodies to help your dog be successful.
- A bait bag or similar small, cloth pouch for the dog's goodies. This is something you can get your hand in-&-out of easily and quickly.
- Wear comfortable clothing and soft soled, closed toe shoes with good traction. Our training facility is located in a warehouse, so please dress appropriately for the weather.
- Water and bowl for your individual pet.
